



Teaching with Talent, Knowledge and Skill

Course Description: A strength can be considered one part knowledge, one part skill and one part talent. When teaching, knowledge (information you know, facts you have learned), skill (ability to perform the basic steps of an activity) and talent (innate way of thinking, behaving, feeling) are needed. Consciously using one's strength when teaching is the hallmark of a remarkable teacher.

This course is designed to help participants reflect on how their identity (as learners and individuals) shapes their teaching practice. Participants will also gain a better understanding of their strengths and how they can be used to positively influence their teaching practice.
